HARRISON COUNTY COURT HOUSE

At the regular meeting of the County Commission of Harrison County held on Wednesday, October 31, 2018. Commissioners Ron Watson, Bernie Fazzini and David Hinkle were present. Also present were Susan Thomas, County Clerk, and Willie Parker, County Administrator. Commissioner Watson opened the meeting and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

- 1. Consent Agenda Fazzini made a motion to approve. Motion carried.
- 2. Payroll Change Notices: 1) David Keener Leave Without Pay Janitorial Staff; 2) Donna Stuart Leave Without Pay Parks and Recreation Fazzini made a motion to approve. Motion carried.
- 3. Exonerations Corrective Tickets Joint Property Applications Fazzini made a motion to approve. Motion carried.
- 4. Consolidations of Land Segregations of Land None
- 5. Letter from Summit Park Volunteer Fire Association Request for vehicle to be used for emergency medical calls Kevin Snyder, President of the Summit Park Volunteer Fire Department stated that they are requesting a 4-wheel drive vehicle for use on narrow streets. Mr. Watson suggested that they defer the issue to Mr. Parker so that he can check to see if there is any surplus that might be available to help the fire department with their request. Fazzini made a motion to defer to Mr. Parker. Motion carried.
- 6. Letter from Earl F. Young Trucks parking in front of BFS on Rt. 50 West Sheriff Matheny advised that Lieutenant Johnson is working on the situation.
- 7. E-mail from Vanessa Perkins, General Manager CENTRA Request to reappoint Tom Durrett to the Board of Directors 3 yr term 10-1-18 to 9-30-2021 Fazzini made a motion to approve. Motion carried.
- 8. WVU Extension Office Service Contract for maintenance on Ricoh D3343 11-1-18 to 10-31-19 Mr. Parker explained the MCM business service contract that is for equipment located at the extension service. Fazzini made a motion to approve. Motion carried.

- 9. Consideration Discussion Review of Various Functions and Responsibilities of Land use Planning Development Update or Status Report on Various Aspects of the Development Mr. Parker explained the various issues that have been discussed. Mr. Watson asked about the job description and evaluation of the Planning Commission director. Mr. Hinkle asked about the amount of time used on rails to trails and PSD's and planning with local towns. Fazzini believes removing rails to trails from Planning Commission will relieve Ms. Shaffer of some of her duties. Mr. Parker stated they met with the Assistant Prosecutor in regards to some properties that were discussed earlier. Mr. Hinkle asked that Mr. Parker and Ms. Shaffer work on bill to introduce in Charleston in regards to building codes that would exempt agricultural land.
- 10. Request to Travel Richard Southall, Community Corrections Drug & Alcohol Assessment requested by Judge Aloi 10-31-18 Tygart Valley Regional Jail Fazzini made a motion to approve. Motion carried.

10:15 a.m. Estate of Salvatore Clemente – Petition to resign as Executrix - Mr. Parker explained the petition. Mr. Robert Greer spoke on behalf of the executrix and her reasons for wanting to resign. Fazzini made a motion to appoint the Sheriff as Administrator of the Estate. Motion carried. Mr. Greer will prepare the order appointing the Sheriff as Administrator.

10:30 a.m. Tom Aman – To consider adoption by the County Commission an Order approving and creating a Tax Increment Financing District in Harrison County to be known as The County Commission of Harrison County Development District No. 6 – North Central West Virginia Airport (the "TIF District"), approving Project Plan No. 1 for the TIF District, establishing a tax increment financing fund and providing for other matters in connection therewith. Mr. Aman explained what the TIF supports. The Bond office has awarded \$45,000,000.00 of the \$75,000,000.00 that they asked for. Mr. Aman explained that an order would be needed from the Commission that would create the district, establish a TIF fund, and approve the project plan. Mr. Aman presented a large map showing the district and gave an overview of the area. Fazzini made a motion to adopt the order and direct the president to affix his signature to the document. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Joan Snoderly asked about how properties were picked for public nuisance considerations.

Fazzini made a motion to go into Executive Session, pursuant to WV Code, to discuss Item No. 11. Motion carried.

11. Discussion – Consideration regarding all options related to the employment status for Nicholas P. Mutafis

Note: The Commission retuned to open session and advised this matter will be on the agenda for next week. Parker & Mutafis will contact WV Counties Risk Pool for updates as to workers' compensation status.

With no further business to come before the Commission, meeting adjourned.
