#### BEFORE THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF HARRISON COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

#### FIREWORKS DISCHARGE RESTRICTION ORDINANCE

The Harrison County Commission, West Virginia, ("the Commission"), hereby finds that the discharge of fireworks devices without restriction as to time of day or to proximity to residential and other venues of rest, relaxation, and sleep is a public nuisance.

Accordingly, pursuant to West Virginia Code§ 7-1-Jkk, the following Ordinance is adopted and shall be in full force and effect on and after\_\_\_\_\_.

(a) No person, firm, or legal entity of any kind shall use or discharge fireworks within the confines of Harrison County, not including any incorporated municipality, except that such fireworks which are permitted by West Virginia Legislative Statute may be discharged on New Year's Eve, during the hours of 9:00 o'clock p.m. and 11:59 o' clock p.m. and on New Year's Day, during the hours of 12:00 o'clock a.m. and 12:30 o'clock a.m.; and, on July 3 between the ours of 9:00 o'clock p.m. and an 11:59 o'clock a.m. until 12:30 o'clock a.m., and, again from 9:00 o'clock p.m. until 11:59 p.m., only. Discharge of approved fireworks as aforesaid may also be accomplished on the Friday and Saturday preceding and following New Year's Eve and on July 4, during the hours above referenced. In addition, such fireworks may be discharged between the hours of 5 o'clock p.m. and 10:00 o'clock p.m. on any other day of the year.

(b) Discharge of such permitted fireworks during any of the times herein referenced is not permitted within 500 linear, straight-line feet of the outer perimeter wall of any residential structure, motel, hotel, bed and breakfast, hospital, nursing home or other facility in which people live, sleep or rest. For purposes of this Ordinance, the location of discharge shall be the physical location where fireworks are lit and/or ignited and/or setoff.

(c) Firework or fireworks means any composition or device designed for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, deflagration or detonation. Fireworks include consumer fireworks, display fireworks and special effects. Fireworks does not include sparkling devices, novelties, top caps or model rockets. Consumer fireworks means small fireworks devices that are designed to produce visible effects by combustion that are required to comply with the construction, chemical composition and labeling regulations promulgated by the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission pursuant to 16 C.F.R. Parts 1500 and 1507 (2014), and that are listed in APA Standard 87-1. Display fireworks means large fireworks to be used solely by professional pyre-technicians licensed by the State Fire Marshal and designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration or detonation and includes, but is not limited to, salutes containing more than two grains (one hundred thirty milligrams) of explosive materials, aerial shells containing more than forty grams of pyrotechnic compositions and other display pieces that exceed the limits of explosive materials for classification as consumer fireworks and are classified as fireworks UN0333, UN0334, or UN0335 pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 172.101 (2014). Special effects means a combination of chemical elements or chemical compounds capable of burning independently of the oxygen of the atmosphere and designed and intended to produce an audible, visual, mechanical or thermal effect as an integral part of a motion picture, radio,

television, theatrical or opera production or live entertainment. (Definitions pursuant to West Virginia Code § 29-3E-2).

(d) Violation of the provisions of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable, upon conviction thereof, by fine of \$1,000.00. Each discharge of a fireworks device in violation of this Ordinance shall be a separate offense.

(e) This Ordinance shall not apply to lawfully permitted fairs, festivals and events.

#### PROPERTY SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Property Settlement Agreement ("Agreement"), made and entered into on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2024, by and between Joshua Travis Weddle ("Husband") and Candice Paige Weddle ("Wife").

WHEREAS the parties were married on June 2, 2018, in Troup County, Georgia;

WHEREAS the parties last lived and cohabited together as Husband and Wife in Marion

County, West Virginia, on or about October 15, 2024;

WHEREAS the parties have no minor children;

WHEREAS irreconcilable differences have arisen between the parties to the extent that

they are no longer able to live together as Husband and Wife;

WHEREAS an action for divorce is anticipated to be filed in the Family Court of Marion County, West Virginia;

WHEREAS the parties hereto desire to more fully define their respective obligations to each other and to record their understanding of what those rights and obligations shall be upon the entry of a Decree of Divorce by said Court; and, WHEREAS the parties intend this Agreement to be a full and final settlement of all property and spousal support issues arising from their marriage and all issues regarding property, real or personal, wheresoever situate, that they own or may acquire together and separately.

#### **IT IS THEREFORE AGREED**:

1. **PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT**: This agreement has been entered into between the parties for the purpose of defining their respective rights and obligations upon the entry of a Decree of Divorce for an action to be filed in the Family Court of Marion County, West Virginia, and agree that this Agreement shall be submitted to the Court with the request that this Agreement and its terms be approved, confirmed, and incorporated into any Decree of Divorce. The execution of this Agreement shall constitute that request.

2. **SEPARATION OF THE PARTIES**: The parties have lived separate and apart since October 15, 2024, and shall continue to live separate and apart, free from interference, direct or indirect, from the other as though unmarried. Each party may, for his or her separate benefit, engage in any employment, business, or profession he or she may choose.

3. **SPOUSAL SUPPORT**: Each party expressly waives any claim he or she may have against the other now and in the future for spousal support by way of alimony and said waiver shall survive any subsequent change of circumstances, as said waiver is permanent and non-modifiable. The Court shall have no further jurisdiction over this issue after the entry of the Decree of Divorce.

4. **REAL PROPERTY**: The parties agree that the former marital home, located at 1115 Fleming Avenue, Fairmont, Marion County, West Virginia shall be sold. Until its sale, Wife shall be entitled sole exclusive possession of said property. The parties shall equally share all debt and costs associated with said property, including, but not limited to, monthly mortgage payments, utilities, insurance, taxes, and maintenance. Each party shall cooperate in listing the home through Rochelle Nikzed and shall follow the realtor's recommendations regarding listing price and any subsequent reductions thereto. The parties shall make any agreed-upon repairs to the home, to be paid from their joint savings account at WesBanco. Upon the sale of the home, each party shall be entitled to one-half of any net sales proceeds.

#### 5. PERSONAL PROPERTY:

A. Husband shall have sole exclusive possession of the 2016 Jeep Wrangler vehicle which is currently in his possession. Husband shall be solely responsible for all debts and costs associated with said vehicle, including, but not limited to, monthly loan payments, taxes, insurance, and maintenance, and shall indemnify and hold Wife harmless on the same.

B. Wife shall have sole exclusive possession of the 2015 Toyota Rav-4 vehicle which is currently in her possession. Wife shall be solely responsible for all debt and costs associated with said vehicle, including, but not limited to, monthly loan payments, taxes, insurance, and maintenance, and shall indemnify and hold Husband harmless on the same.

C. The parties agree that they shall cooperate to divide their remaining personal property in kind, with each receiving an equal share of the same. Each party shall be entitled to his/her personal effects, clothing, and any items of separate property.

#### 6. FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS AND RETIREMENT:

A. Wife shall retain sole exclusive possession of her WVU Medicine 401k and 403b accounts and any other accounts held solely in her name, or held with any individual other than Husband, except as set forth herein. Husband expressly waives any interest he may have in said accounts. B. Husband shall retain sole exclusive possession of any financial accounts held solely in his name, or held with any individual other than Wife, except as set forth herein.
Wife expressly waives any interest she may have in said accounts.

C. The parties shall equally divide the joint WesBanco savings account after first paying the costs of any agreed-upon repairs to the former marital home necessary to make the home marketable.

D. The parties agree that the joint WesBanco checking account shall be closed upon the sale of the home as set forth in Section 4, above.

 LIFE INSURANCE: Each party shall retain sole possession of any life insurance policy currently registered in his or her name.

8. **DEBT**:

A. The mortgage associated with the former marital home shall be paid in accordance with Paragraph 4a, above.

B. Husband shall be solely responsible for the debt secured by the 2016 Jeep Wrangler vehicle, the Discover credit card debt, his student loan debt, and any other debts held solely in his name or held with any other individual other than Wife. He shall indemnify and hold Wife harmless from the same.

C. Wife shall be solely responsible for the debt secured by the 2015 Toyota Rav-4 vehicle, her Discover credit card debt, her Visa credit card debt, her student loan debt, and any other debts held solely in her name or held with any other individual other than Husband. She shall indemnify and hold Husband harmless from the same.

D. Neither of the parties hereto shall from the date of this Agreement incur or contract, in any manner, any debts or obligations to the credit of or in the name of the other, and

each does hereby release the other from any and all further duty or obligation to furnish support other than as set forth in this Agreement.

9. EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION: Neither party shall owe the other an equalizing payment in order to effectuate equitable distribution. Each party shall waive any additional credits to which he/she may otherwise be entitled.

10. TAXES: Each party shall be solely responsible for payment of, and shall pay promptly when due, all taxes and assessments and deficiencies in taxes and assessments for property held solely in his/her name or solely in his/her possession pursuant to this Agreement. Each party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other party from such liabilities, assessments, deficiencies, penalties, interest and other costs, including, but not limited to, attorney and accountant fees. The parties acknowledge they have been advised that there may be tax consequences pertaining to this Agreement and each party has had the opportunity to obtain independent tax advice prior to signing the Agreement.

11. **MUTUAL RELEASE**: Subject to the provisions herein, each party and his/her heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns releases and forever discharges the other of and from all causes of action, claims, rights, or demands whatsoever, in law or equity, which either of the parties had or now has against the other.

#### 12. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS:

A. This Agreement shall not be modified except by the parties hereto, by written instrument executed in the same manner at this instrument, or by subsequent Order of the Court upon petition by either party duly served upon the other. Both parties hereby expressly waive any request for modification, to the extent allowed by law, and express their desire, and agreement with the other, that the agreement set forth herein shall never be modified but instead shall be strictly enforced as written. Failure of either party to insist upon strict performance of any provision of this Agreement shall not be deemed to be a waiver of the right to insist upon strict performance of such provision or any other provision of this Agreement at any time.

B. Husband hereby releases, relinquishes, grants and forever quit claims unto Wife all of his right of election, right of distribution, and all other rights, whether at common law, in equity, or by statute, which he now has or may hereafter have by reason of being her Husband, out of any and all estate, real or personal, which she now has or may hereafter acquire, except as outlined in this Agreement.

C. Wife hereby releases, relinquishes, grants and forever quit claims unto Husband all of her right of election, right of distribution, and all other rights, whether at common law, in equity, or by statute, which she now has or may hereafter have by reason of being his Wife, out of any and all estate, real or personal, which he now has or may hereafter acquire, except as outlined in this Agreement.

D. This instrument is not binding upon the parties until executed and acknowledged by both of them.

E. With respect to each party's responsibility for payment of certain debts and liabilities, and their obligation to hold the other harmless for the payment thereof, the parties understand and agree that their obligation is a non-dischargeable debt under the bankruptcy code, this obligation being part of the final financial support settlement for both parties.

F. If either party fails in the performance of any of his or her obligations under this Agreement, each shall have the right, at his or her election, to sue for damages for a breach hereof, or seek such other legal and equitable remedies as may be available to the other. Should either party incur any expenses or legal fees as a result of the breach of any portion of this Agreement by the other party, the Court shall award reasonable attorney's fees and costs which are reasonably incurred to the non-defaulting party.

G. Each party hereto acknowledges that no representations of any kind have been made to him or her as an inducement to enter into this Agreement, other than the representations set forth herein, and that this Agreement contains all of the terms of the contract between the Parties.

H. This Agreement may be executed in duplicate originals or copies, and the duplicate originals or copies shall have the same force and effect as the original.

I. Each party agrees to execute, acknowledge, and deliver to the other party such further documents as may hereafter be reasonably requested or required to carry out the terms of this Agreement.

J. This Agreement shall be binding, not only on the parties hereto, but also upon the respective heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns of said parties.

K. If any portion of this Agreement shall be found to be illegal or legally unenforceable, Husband and Wife agree that such portion shall be severed from the Agreement, and the remainder of the Agreement shall survive and shall be construed to most closely effect the purposes of the Agreement in its entirety.

L. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of West Virginia in a forum located in Marion County, West Virginia. The parties acknowledge that this Agreement was prepared by Samantha L. Koreski, Esq., who is representing the Husband.

M. Husband and Wife shall be solely responsible for any and all court costs s/he has incurred in this proceeding.

N. Each party is entering into this Agreement with full understanding of its terms and provisions and with full financial disclosure by the other party. Each party is doing so under his/her own free will, without any fraud, duress, coercion, or undue influence by the other party or by any other person on behalf of such party. The Parties further declare that each has had the right of independent legal advice by counsel of his or her own selection; that each has been fully apprised as to the full nature and extent of the assets and liabilities of the other and of the legal rights of each; and, that after such knowledge and/or information, each signs this Agreement freely and voluntarily, and that neither is relying upon any representation other than those expressly set forth herein. No oral statement or prior written matter extrinsic to this Agreement shall have any force or effect. Each party acknowledges that the terms and provisions of this Agreement are in all respects fair, reasonable, and equitable.

O. The parties hereby acknowledge that Husband is represented by Samantha L. Koreski, Esq. in this proceeding, and that Wife is not represented in this proceeding. Wife acknowledges that she has been given the opportunity to consult with her own independent legal counsel prior to signing this agreement.

13. **COMPLETE AGREEMENT**: This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties. There are no representations, warranties, promises, covenants, or undertakings other than those expressly set forth herein.

- 1. That this Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein, and venue is proper with this Court.
- Both parties have been residents of the state of West Virginia for a period of one (1) year prior to the filing of this action.
- 3. Both parties currently reside in Harrison County, West Virginia.
- 4. The parties were duly married in Harrison County, West Virginia, on or about May 27, 2017.
- The parties last cohabited as husband and wife on or about July 25, 2024 in Harrison County, West Virginia.

#### PROPERTY SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 28th day of January 2025, by and between Geoffrey Marcus Nicholson, party of the first part, hereinafter referred to as "Husband", and Danielle Leann Nicholson, party of the second part, hereinafter referred to as "Wife".

NOW THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT, WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the promises, covenants and agreements herein contained to be observed, kept and performed, and upon the terms, provisions, conditions and stipulations herein set forth the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That the Parties intend this Property Settlement Agreement as a settlement of all property issues arising from their marriage, and all issues regarding property, real and personal, wheresoever situate, that they own or may acquire together and separately.

 In preparation of this Settlement Agreement, each Party has been represented by separate legal Counsel: Travis Britton and Kimberly Kosloski for Wife and Debra V. Chafin for Husband, prior to the execution of this agreement.

3. The Parties acknowledge that neither attorney has furnished tax advice with respect to this Property Settlement Agreement, and each Party has had the opportunity to obtain independent tax advice prior to signing this Property Settlement Agreement.

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#### 4. SEPARATION OF THE PARTIES.

That the parties have and shall continue to live apart for the rest of their lives. Each shall be free from interference, direct or indirect, by the other as though unmarried. Each may for his or her separate benefit engage in any employment, business, or profession he or she may choose. That the parties shall not molest or interfere with each other, nor shall either attempt to compel the other to cohabitate or dwell with him or her by any means whatsoever.

#### 5. <u>REAL PROPERTY.</u>

A. The Husband will be awarded exclusive use, title and possession of the home located at 524 S. Fifth Street, Clarksburg, West Virginia which was Husband's premarital property. Husband shall be responsible for the debt, taxes, insurance, and maintenance for the same and indemnify and hold Wife harmless for the same. The debt is solely in Husband's name.

#### 6. PERSONALTY.

A. That Wife shall have as her sole and separate property all items of personal clothing, jewelry and items of a personal nature, all items of tangible personal property in Wife's possession not hereinbefore specifically mentioned, including, and the 2015 Toyota Tacoma and the 2014 Rav 4. Wife shall then be responsible for the taxes, insurance and maintenance associated with said vehicle and indemnify and hold Husband harmless for the same.

B. Husband shall have as his sole and separate property his personal clothing, jewelry and items of a personal nature, all items of tangible personal property presently in his possession, and the 2009 Ford Taurus, the 1977 Ford Mustang, the 2019 Yamaha Kodiak, and Husband shall be responsible for the taxes, insurance and maintenance for the same and indemnify. Husband shall indemnify and hold Wife harmless for the same.

#### 7. FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS.

A. Each party shall have exclusive ownership and possession of the financial accounts titled in his or her name. Husband's accounts were at the FFCU and Wife's accounts were at WesBanco.

**B.** Husband shall retain his retirement benefits in his name which includes his Security Police Fire Professionals of America Retirement Plan managed by Principal, and Wife waives any interest in and to the same. Wife shall retain her retirement benefits in her name and Husband waives any interest in and to the same.

C. Each party shall retain life insurance in his or her respective names.

#### 8. DEBTS AND LIABILITIES

A. Husband shall be responsible for any and all debts incurred during the marriage and by him or for his benefit including the SOFI debt of \$30,000.00, the USAA x4481 of \$505.32, the USAA x4688 of \$488.68, the Capital Once of \$1,728.61, the Chase Freedom credit card of \$1,618.44, the 2024 personal property taxes of \$576.70, the Synchronicity credit card of \$277.76, the 2022 personal property taxes of \$236.60, the 2023 personal property taxes of \$297.88, any medical bills in his name, and any debts incurred by him after separation. Husband shall indemnify and hold Wife harmless therefrom.

B. Wife shall be responsible for any debts incurred during the marriage and by her or for her benefit including any credit card debt in her name, her student loan debts, any medical bills in her name and any debts incurred after separation. Wife and shall hold Husband harmless therefrom. C. Each party shall be responsible for his or her own personal or business tax debts and indemnify and hold the other harmless from the same.

D. It is understood and agreed between the Parties that each has separate debts, unaffected by the settlement herein, and each shall remain solely responsible for their own separate debts.

E. Each Party shall be solely responsible for payment of, and shall pay promptly when due, all taxes and assessments and deficiencies in taxes and assessments, together with interest and penalties, connected with the ownership of the property herein delineated. Each Party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other Party from all such liabilities, assessments, deficiencies penalties, interest, and other costs, including but not limited to, attorney and accountant fees.

#### 9. EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION.

A. Neither party shall pay the other any equalizing payment in equitable distribution.

#### 10. SPOUSAL SUPPORT AND ATTONEY'S FEES

A. Both parties are waiving spousal support/alimony from the other, forever, without regard to any change in circumstances. No Court shall have jurisdiction to consider this issue.

B. In the event that either party files for Bankruptcy and obtains a discharge for a debt addressed in this agreement to the detriment of the other party or if the bankruptcy filing of the other party has violated the property settlement agreement of the parties or otherwise obligates the other party for a debt assumed hereunder, the aggrieved party may petition this Court for spousal support to the extent necessary to repay the debt, carrying out the intention of this agreement.

C. Each Party shall pay his or her own attorney fees and other costs of this divorce action.

#### 11. WAIVER OF CLAIM AGAINST ESTATE

Except as otherwise provided, each party hereby waives and relinquishes any and all rights he or she may have or hereafter acquire under the present or future laws of any jurisdiction to share in the property or the estate of the other as a result of the marital relationship including, without limitation, statutory allowance, widow's allowance, homestead rights, right to take intestacy, right to take against the will of the other, and right to act as administrator or executor of the others estate, and each party will, at the request of the other, execute, acknowledge and deliver any and all instruments which may be necessary or advisable to carry into effect this mutual waiver and relinquishment of all such interests, rights and claim. Each party waives his or her right to claim an elective share in the surviving spouse's augmented estate.

#### 12. MUTUAL RELEASE

Subject to the provisions of this Agreement, each party has released and discharged, and by this Agreement, does for himself and his or her heirs, legal representatives, executors, administrators, and assigns, release and discharge the other of and from all causes of action, claims, rights or demands whatsoever, in law or equity, which either of the parties ever had or now has against the other, except any or all causes of action for divorce.

#### 13. INDEMNIFICATION

Husband agrees he shall be responsible for any charges that he is liable for under this Agreement and indemnify and hold Wife harmless for the same in the event she is required to pay any said charges. The Wife agrees to be reciprocally responsible for any charges that she is liable for under this Agreement and indemnify Husband in the event that he is required to pay any said charges.

The parties further declare that each has had the right of independent legal advice by counsel of his or her own selection; that each has been fully apprised as to the full nature and extent of the assets and liabilities of each other and of the legal rights of each, and that after such advice, knowledge and information, each signs this Agreement freely and voluntarily, and neither relying upon any representation other than those expressly set forth herein. No oral statement or prior written matter extrinsic to this Agreement shall have any force or effect.

#### 15. JURISDICTION

This Property Settlement Agreement was entered into in the State of West Virginia, and its validity, effect, and operation shall be determined according to the laws of the State of West Virginia.

#### 16. FULL DISCLOSURE

The practical effect of this Agreement in each and every respect and the financial status of the parties have been fully understood by both parties, and they both acknowledge that it is a fair Agreement. Both parties have relied on the financial disclosure of the other in making this agreement.

#### 17. AVOIDANCE OF PRIOR AGREEMENTS

The parties hereby avoid in <u>toto</u> any and all prior separation agreements made by them at any time heretofore, and declare them to be <u>nullis juris</u>.

#### 18. FAILURE OF PERFORMANCE

If the Husband and Wife fail in the due performance of any of their obligations hereunder, each shall have the right, at his or her election, to sue for damages for a breach hereof, or seek such other legal and equitable remedies as may be available to the other.

#### 19. SOLE PROPERTY OF HUSBAND
